NEW BANKNOTE CHARITY COLLECTIVE SETS

With the issuance of the newly designed banknotes for public circulation, Hong Kong's three note-issuing banks – Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited, The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited and Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited have generously donated new HK\$500 and HK\$1,000 banknotes with matching serial numbers to The Community Chest of Hong Kong for fund-raising purposes.

Consistent with the previous series, the newly designed banknotes adopt the same colour scheme. The different designs feature beautiful natural scenery, significant landmarks of Hong Kong, the images of local celebration activities as well as Chinese inventions. Braille and tactile lines have been added to help people with visual impairments to differentiate the various denominations.

All funds raised will be allocated in full, with no deductions for administrative expenses, to the Chest's 150 member social welfare agencies.

B) Eminent Series

Terms and Conditions

Each "New Banknote Charity Collective Set" consists of three HK\$500 and three HK\$1,000 banknotes with matching serial numbers issued by Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited, The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited and Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited respectively.

A) Criteria for bidders/subscribers

The bidder/subscriber must be at least <u>18 years old or above</u> and can provide his/her <u>Hong Kong Identity Card number</u> as well as <u>a valid Hong Kong address</u>.

B) Quantity for bidding/subscription

1) Supreme Series

- a) Each person is allowed to bid for more than one set.
- b) The banknote set will go to <u>the highest bidder</u> if more than one bids are being received.

2) Eminent Series

a) Each person is allowed to subscribe one set only.

C) Deadline for bidding/subscription

 $12{:}00\ \mathrm{noon}$ on 20 February 2012. Any application received after the deadline will not be accepted.

G) Payment

All cheques or banker's cashier orders sent in with the Application Forms will be presented for payment immediately without any further notification.

H) Void or Cancellation

- 1) All bids lower than the minimum bidding price will be void.
- 2) Bids or subscriptions will be cancelled if the cheques or banker's cashier orders do not comply with the above requirements or are dishonoured upon presentation.
- 3) All bids or subscriptions, once submitted, cannot be changed or withdrawn.

I) Result Announcement of bidding/subscription

- The result of bidding/subscription will be announced on the Chest website on or after 9 March 2012.
- "Written Notification" will be sent by ordinary post to each successful subscriber to the address stated on the Application Form, at his/her own risk for postal error if any, on or after 9 March 2012.

J) Collection

- Successful bidders/subscribers should present the "Written Notification" and his/her Hong Kong Identity Card to collect the "New Banknote Charity Collective Sets" in person during the specified period at the Chest Office. Delivery service is not provided.
- 2) Selection or exchange of serial number is not allowed.
- All collective sets should be checked and acknowledged receipt on the spot. Subsequent requests for exchange or return will not be entertained.
- Successful bidders/subscribers will receive an official donation receipt issued by The Community Chest of Hong Kong.

D) Bidding/subscription procedures

- The bidders/subscribers should send the completed Application Form together with a separate cheque/ banker's cashier order for each bidding or subscription for "New Banknote Charity Collective Sets".
- 2) Must be paid by a crossed cheque or by a banker's cashier order.
- All cheques or cashier orders should be made payable to "The Community Chest of Hong Kong".
- 4) Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
- 5) "New Banknote Charity Collective Sets" to be marked on the envelope.
- 6) If two or more bids are received with the same amount for a particular number for the "Supreme Series", the set will be allocated through a ballot draw.
- 7) If there is over subscription for the "Eminent Series", The Community Chest of Hong Kong will draw lots to determine successful subscriptions.
- 8) The draw will be witnessed by KPMG.

E) If the bidder/subscriber pays by cheque:

- The cheque must be drawn from the bidder's/subscriber's Hong Kong dollar bank account in Hong Kong.
- 2) The cheque must show the account holder's name. The name must either be preprinted on the cheque, or be endorsed on the back by a person authorized by the bank. This account name must correspond with the bidder's/subscriber's name on the Application Form.

F) If the bidder/subscriber pays by banker's cashier order:

- 1) The cashier order must be issued by a bank in Hong Kong.
- The reverse side of the banker's cashier order should be endorsed by the issuing bank confirming the name of the bidder/subscriber.

K) Refund

- Refund cheque(s), without interest, will be sent by ordinary post to the address stated on the Application Form, at the risk of bidder/subscriber for postal error if any, on or after 15 March 2012 for any unsuccessful bids or subscriptions.
- 2) Request for refund is not allowed for successful bids or subscriptions.

In case of any disputes, the decision of The Community Chest of Hong Kong shall be final.
