B. Race Briefing Notes

1. Participants must ensure that they are physically fit to participate in the event. Any person who is pregnant or suffering from chronic diseases such as heart disease or high blood pressure should not join the event.
2. The Organiser will provide Public Liability Insurance only for the event. Participants are reminded to arrange their own Personal Accident Insurance if necessary.
3. Please peruse the Important Notice and Rules of the event which is uploaded on Chest website: http://www.commchest.org/filemanager/uploadfiles/events/cycling2014/Open_Rules_Eng.pdf
4. Participants can present the Number Cloth to enter the venue and each participant can bring two relatives or friends to join. Relatives and friends must take shuttle bus provided by the Organiser by presenting the enclosed Boarding passes* at Chik Wan Street, Tai Wai (Tai Wai MTR Station Exit F & G) to reach the Start Point and for return journey.
5. On the event day, participants are required to arrive at Route 8 Toll Plaza **45 minutes before the race starts**.
6. Bag drop service will be provided on the event day. Please take a plastic bag on-site, put the personal belongings in it and tie the luggage tag to the plastic bag. Participants should not leave valuable items in the bag and any loss will be at their own risk.
7. All participants are **required to wear bike helmets** during the event. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse any participant who does not wear or use the helmet improperly.
8. Please follow the instructions of the commissaires and marshals to ensure the race is held smoothly in a fair and safe manner.

C. Traffic Arrangement

1. On event day, Route 8 will be temporarily closed off. Except the Organiser's designated working vehicles, all other vehicles and general public will NOT be allowed to enter the closed area.
2. Participants who do not bring their own bikes are required to take shuttle bus at Chik Wan Street, Tai Wai (Tai Wai MTR Station Exit F & G) by presenting the Number Cloth to the Start Point and for return journey.

3. Relatives and friends must take shuttle bus provided by the Organiser by presenting the enclosed Boarding passes* to reach the Start Point and for return journey.
4. **NO** Shuttle bus will be provided for participants who bring their own bikes. They are required to use cycling track to reach Che Kung Miu Road and go to the Start Point at Route 8 Toll Plaza. There is a 10-minute steep road where cycling is NOT allowed. The whole journey is a 30-minute walk.
5. Drop-off at Che Kung Miu Road is NOT allowed.

D. Frame Number with Timing Chip

Please tear off the Frame Number (Photo 1) with Timing Chip and put it properly at the seat post (Photo 2 & 3).

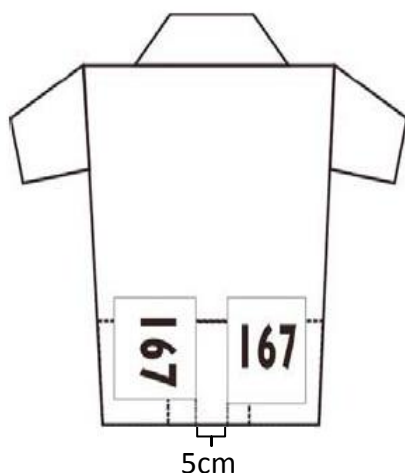
